What It Is...

Benefits

° Meets nutritional needs of growing, breeding and performance horses when fed as recommended with good quality hay. No need to feed additional supplements.

° Helps pregnant mares develop strong, healthy foals and promotes development of strong bones, tendons and muscle in growing horses.

° Minerals help horses in training and performing to maintain and further increase bone strength.

° Added selenium and Vitamin E make up for natural deficiencies which can lead to muscle damage and reproductive problems.

° Helps build horse's stamina and endurance which enhances the ability of horses to perform.

° Reduces risk of colic and other digestive disturbances from high grain feeding.

° Decrease bone and tendon problems in rapidly growing horses caused by high grain.

° Improve temperament of horses which become hyperactive when fed high levels of grain.

° Optimizes growth and muscle development in young horses and fetal development and milk production in brood mares.

° Improves overall appearance and condition of skin, hair and hooves which results in shinier, healthy looking horses.

Benefits

° Blood-building nutrients needed for high blood counts and cardiovascular capacity as well as nutrients needed to facilitate other biological processes.

How To Feed...

Start with the amounts given for the weight and class of horse. After observing the horse for a period of time, the amount fed may be increased or decreased by 10% to obtain the desired body condition and weight. More specific recommendations may also be obtained from a Purina representative.

Always feed a **minimum** of 1% of body weight of good quality, clean hay or pasture. Inadequate amounts of poor quality hay may lead to colic and other digestive disturbances. Salt should also be fed free-choice to all horses.

Mature, Idle Horses - Feed amount of Strategy-Professional Formula GX equivalent to 1/2% of body weight per day along with hay and/or pasture.

Pregnant Mares (last 120 days) - Feed amount of Strategy-Professional Formula GX equivalent to 2/3 - 3/4% of body weight per day along with hay and/or pasture. Feed as mature, idle horse in early pregnancy.

Lactating Mares (up to 150 days) - Feed amount of Strategy-Professional Formula GX equivalent to 1-1/4 - 1-1/2% of body weight per day. Feed three times daily along with hay or pasture.

Breeding Stallions (during breeding season) - Feed amount of Strategy-Professional Formula GX equivalent to 3/4 - 1% of body weight per day along with hay and/or pasture. Feed as mature, idle horse after breeding season.

Horses in Training - Feed amount of Strategy-Professional Formula GX equivalent to 3/4 to 1-1/4% of body weight per day along with hay. Amount fed should be varied according to body condition and stage and intensity of training.

Growing Weanling and Yearling Horses - Feed amount of Strategy-Professional Formula GX equivalent to 1 to 1-1/2% of body weight per day along with hay or pasture. Feed at the high rate if rapid growth is desired.

Suckling Foal - Feed Strategy-Professional Formula GX at a rate of 1 pound per month of age per day.

Important Considerations:

1. **DO NOT** feed free-choice. Any feed changes should be made gradually over a period of 7 to 10 days. Changes in the rate of feeding should not exceed one pound per day for each horse. Feed at regular times -- at least twice daily -- with three daily feedings preferred, when feeding rates exceed 1% of body weight
2. Reduce and/or delay feeding a horse which is hot, excited or showing pain, fever or diarrhea. Let horse feed in a natural position from troughs with large bottoms, placed at normal head height or lower. Have plenty of fresh, clean water available at all times
3. Maintain an effective control program for internal parasites.. Be sure that horses are free of dental problems. Prevent the rapid eating by the horses of any feedstuff
4. Observe your horse's condition daily. Consult your veterinarian if any problems arise
5. Common ailments of the horse include colic, founder and choke. Prevention and treatment are difficult because the causative factors may not be readily identifiable. But with proper health care and feeding management, these potential problems can be minimized. Should any of them occur, obtain immediate veterinary assistance
6. Choke (blockage of the esophagus) can occur if chewing and/or salivation is insufficient. To minimize these dangers, provide plenty of water, prevent the bolting of feed, and correct all dental problems. If feed should become lodged in the esophagus, call your veterinarian immediately. Horses with chronic choke should receive a thorough medical examination, then follow the veterinarian's recommendations.

Caution: Store in a dry well-ventilated area protected from rodents and insects. **DO NOT** feed moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may cause illness or death.
